ACCOMMODATION AND MEALS

The school residence is located on Great Dover Street, in Zone 1, and offers accommodation in single rooms with private bathrooms, a courtyard, and 24-hour security. The classrooms, social areas, café, and dining hall are just a 15-minute walk from the facility. The residence is a 5-minute walk to Waterloo Station and within a few dozen kilometers of most airports. The safety and well-being of each student is the highest priority. Therefore, Ardmore provides an orientation to the facility, fire drills, student ID cards, emergency contact information, and supervision by a night security guard.
